Her work focuses largely on the natural world, often incorporating nature either in documentation and observation or as an allegorical device. Katie's current body of personal work focuses on wetlands and emphasizing ecosystems that are historically distorted or underrepresented. The approach of the work encapsulates and mimics the vast biodiversity and vibrancy that nature offers on its own. Currently, the body of wetlands work is focused on generating a case study project centered around Cicero Swamp Wildlife Management Area and Oneida Lake, both vast ecosystems located in New York. Selected recognition includes 3x3 International, American Illustration, the Syracuse Poster Project, the Society for News Design, and more. Clients have included the Georgia Museum of Art, The Mushroom Magazine, the Huffington Post, Wyrmwood Gaming, and more.
